Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and further to our intimation dated 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2025, we wish to inform you that the Company has received revocation orders dated 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2025, from the Gujarat Pollution Control Board ("GPCB"), whereby the closure directions dated 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 (received by the Company on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2025), in respect of the Company's following plants, have been revoked:

- Plot No. 83/86 and C1/40/2/3/4, GIDC Estate, Nadiad, Taluka Nadiad, District Kheda; and
- Plot No. 94, GIDC Estate, Nadiad, Taluka Nadiad, District Kheda.

Further, the Company has paid a combined Interim Environmental Damage Compensation of Rs. 11,50,000 (Rupees Eleven Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) to the GPCB, following which the said revocation orders have been issued.

The revocation orders are valid for a period of three months from the date of issuance and are subject to certain conditions, which the Company is required to fulfil. The Company has reviewed the conditions set out in the revocation orders and will take necessary steps to ensure compliance at the earliest.

We assure all our stakeholders that our manufacturing facilities are operated in strict adherence to applicable laws, and we remain committed to maintaining the highest standards of regulatory compliance.

In accordance with Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations, read with SEBI Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2024, and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/CIR/P/2024/185 dated 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024, the required disclosure is enclosed herewith as **Annexure I**.
